Positive key indicators and unchanged high bonus rate

The return for the first six months of 2017 slightly exceeded 3 %, and this good return together with higher interest rates contributed to improved solvency. All the asset categories made a positive contribution, and it was primarily the Swedish stocks that developed most.

This summer saw a reduction in both Swedish and overseas stocks and as a result the return to end August dropped by about 1 %. However, VFF Pension's strong key return to end August dropped by about 1 %. However, VFF Pension's strong key indicators allow us to maintain our bonus rate at a high rate of 12 % for our PLUSpension and 6 % for our occupational pensions.
